Grade Levels: 2-5, with adjustment K-1

OBJECTIVE

Students will exercise their critical thinking skills by evaluating the play.

MATERIALS

- Paper, erasers, markers, crayons, colored pencils, pens, etc.
- "A Letter to Oskar" templates (attached)

PROCEDURE

- After watching Oskar and the Last Straw, give students time to reflect on the show and what they learned. Have them discuss their favorite moments with the class and what they think the most important message of the play was. Then, have students fill out the attached "A Letter to Oskar" template.
