Lotería “Las Posadas”

La Lotería es un juego tradicional mexicano también conocido como Bingo Mexicano! Se juega durante las reuniones familiares, especialmente durante la temporada navideña. Este juego de lotería incluye personajes y artículos clásicos relacionados con la Posada, como la Natividad, la bandera mexicana, la piñata, y los alimentos tradicionales de la Posada: los tamales, los buñuelos, el pavo, el flan, y el rompompé.

Preparación

Imprime y recorta las 26 tarjetas de “Las Posadas”, junto con el número de tarjetas de lotería necesarias para cada jugador.

¡CONSEJO! Antes de jugar, usa las tarjetas para ayudar a los jugadores a acostumbrarse al vocabulario español/inglés.

Juego

Decidan el idioma - español o inglés - ¡depende de ti!

Un jugador grita objetos uno por uno de la baraja de las 26 tarjetas de “Las Posadas”. El resto de los jugadores que tienen la imagen correspondiente en su tarjeta de la Lotería de “Las Posadas” pueden colorear ese cuadro o marcarlo de otra manera.

Ganar el Juego

¡El jugador o jugadores que coloreen primero su tarjeta entera del tablero y digan “Lotería” o “Buenas” ganan! Necesitan verificar su victoria diciendo el nombre de las imágenes ganadoras en su tablero.

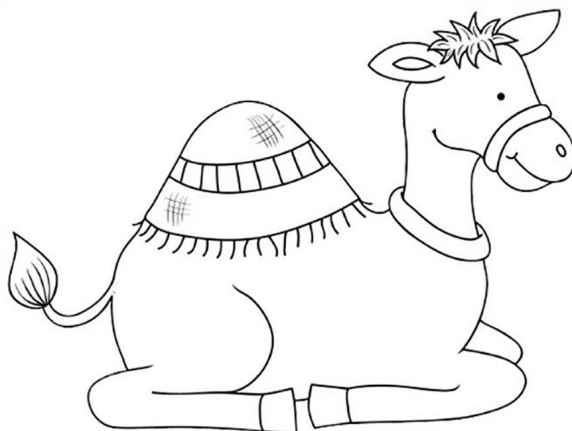

- Colorear las cuatro esquinas o los cuatro cuadrados centrales

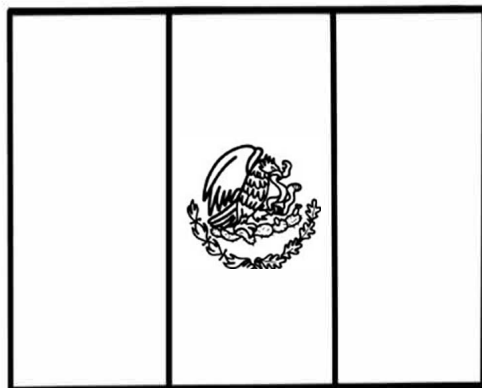
